- On **page 5**, the second bullet in the first row has been moved into a new row. The row header remains "New enrollment opportunities". The middle column reads "**Standard Plan**". The final column continues to read "Employees who are not enrolled but who want to preserve their employee post-retirement contributions for use later, may enroll immediately prior to retirement."
- On **page 14**, *Frequently Asked Question #10* contains new language. The entire answer now reads: "You may each retain or select single coverage, **family coverage** or may select one family plan. See *Frequently Asked Question 12* in the *It's Your Choice: Reference Guide* for details."
